As many of you may remember, in October 2012, Kroger made big changes to its Community Rewards Program, and now it is even easier for you to help Fulbright Elementary every time you shop at Kroger. Kroger no longer requires the use of gift cards in order for Fulbright to receive a percentage of your purchases. This means no more loading gift cards! Instead, Fulbright will receive credit for a percentage of your Kroger purchases simply as a result of you presenting your Kroger Plus card to the cashier. In order for Fulbright to receive credit for your purchases, however, you must go online and link your Kroger Plus card to Fulbright.

To help Fulbright every time you shop, go to <http://www.kroger.com/> and follow these simple instructions:

1. Follow the steps to "Create an account." (This will include having to check your email to confirm your account before you will be able to continue). If you have previously registered your Kroger Plus card online you can just "Sign In."
2. Once you have created an account or signed in you should be able to click on "My Account," then "Account Settings."
3. Once your account settings opens, select "Community Rewards."
4. Then click on "Edit Community Rewards Program Information."
5. Enter your name and address.
6. Type "Fulbright" in the search box.
7. Select the Fulbright Elementary bubble and "Save Changes."

Now you are earning money for Fulbright every time you shop at Kroger. Encourage grandparents, other family, and neighbors to register too.
